The Chair role is, for me a good fit given my chairing experience in sport (taekwondo specifically) and in youth services charities.

My experience of governance matters has been developed over the last 14 years as a Chair and also CEO of two sports governing bodies. Governance has been a major focus for the Scottish Council of Taekwondo (I was Chair but now have the position of CEO – sole employee) as we recently achieved Recognition by the UK Sports Institutes after a particularly rigorous process through which we followed the sportscotland Framework of Good Governance to the letter. Sustaining this while developing participation, a coaching education pathway, our membership/clubs and groups and ensuring compliance with financial, safeguarding and equality standards is now our task. We have a strategy that was developed with this focus.

As an individual with this experience of Governance, I have recently been asked to advise on Governance matters by a Taekwondo Federation in Scotland also an HNGB in Northern Ireland.

My background is one of Management Consultancy in the private sector. Many of the skills developed – particularly in development of income streams have translated well into the not for profit sector.

Sponsorship, partnership and stakeholder development along with management of politics are just some of the skills brought to the sector.

Overall, I have developed a reputation as a leader. Pioneering in some respects but not a maverick. This has been based on good communication complementing other 'management' skills.

Finally, my knowledge and understanding of Lacrosse has been built by involvement in the England Lacrosse project (subsequently shelved) to establish an online officiating portal. I attended several meetings and competitions to better understand the sport including one at Peffermill. At this time I also developed a good understanding of the history and politics.
