



2021 Clean Sport Annual Activity Report

Lacrosse Scotland appointed a Director to the Board in the summer of 2021 to undertake the role of Vice Chair with a responsibility for Governance. A key priority was to engage with UKAD on the Assurance Framework, working towards compliance by April 2022. It's been a busy time:

- Key personnel attended the UKAD Board Workshop and 2021 Clean Sport Forum, and completed WADA and UKAD e-learning modules
- The revised list of prohibited substances was circulated to all Performance & Development athletes
- Junior Performance & Development athletes were provided with information specific to parents and carers of young athletes to help families understand this landscape
- Lacrosse Scotland policies, documents, and membership system were updated to meet the Assurance Framework
- A Clean Sport Education strategy reaching all members and staff has been prepared, and will be implemented in 2022

Lacrosse Scotland co-operated with World Lacrosse on clean sport matters throughout the year, such as providing quarterly "Whereabouts" reporting, providing information about upcoming national squad training sessions and a roster of expected athletes
